CRY norms that a volunteer should adhere to:

- No cash donations may be collected by any volunteer. As far as possible, motivate people to send their donations via Cheques/DDs directly to CRY.
- Volunteers are not permitted to use CRY stationery as their own.
- All CRY literature will be developed by CRY. Any modifications must have CRY's prior approval.
- Volunteers may not release any material pertaining to CRY, in the media (TV/ radio/magazines/newspapers/newsletters etc.), without seeking CRY's prior approval.
- All CRY activities should be coordinated through the contact point in CRY. Please do not directly interface on projects, and with other departments of CRY.
- Volunteers wishing to visit any CRY project, to please allow at least 2 months notice. All related costs (travel, local travel, boarding and lodging etc) to be borne by them.
